1. Call to order, count for quorum. 9 of 17 appointed members in attendance. Two seats remain vacant

2. Approval of minutes from previous meeting. No vote recorded

3. Public Comment

Kevin Burton, WeHo Bike Coalition

West Hollywood will be extending BLs on SM Blvd. and buffered BLs on Fairfax between Wiloughby and Fountain, LA has already installed bike lanes on Fairfax to the north.

4. Bikeways Program, Michelle Mowery, (see her report emailed to us)

Staff are discussing how best to provide an active projects status list to BAC; should happen within a month. Working on their list of projects, evaluating which can move forward near term:

- 2nd cycle track project on Los Angeles street

- Culver Blvd. road diet in Playa del Rey village

LA River projects:

-Army Corp. plans to modify the flood channel in anticipation of El Nino. Will use HESCO sand-filled barriers to raise height of storm water containment. Most will go on east side. Sunnynook Bridge is closed as a result. - Army Corp. "owns" the River.

- Detour will use Crystal Springs, Glendale Blvd, Fletcher, routes to east side; will have orange and black signage all in place.

Wayfinding. Had some tech glitches with maps and sign locations. Should progress soon.

6. Planning Dept., David Somers

David

- Cap and Trade affordable housing grants offer opportunities to submit active transportation projects in concert with housing. Not big projects but more like enhancements to neighborhood bikeways and transit access stuff. Housing projects get points for including active transportation. Planning / DOT would advise on projects but housing project sponsors would be responsible for building them.
